George Johnson is the first and only African American head golf pro in Kentucky. A lifetime member of the PGA, Johnson got his tour card in 1969. Today, he can play the Senior Tour whenever he likes. His career took him through 10 years on the PGA tour, and an assistant pro position at Victory Drive Golf course in Columbus, Georgia from 1980 to 1987. Johnson has also played an integral role recruiting young golfers for the Louisville Urban League's Urban Golf Program and the Junior Golf Programs of the Metro Parks Department. But, he's teaching more than the game of golf. He's teaching the game of life.
